The Reggio Children Foundation is looking for two Atelieristas

Working area

The LEGO Foundation and the Reggio Children Foundation are collaborating on a research project, called DigiAtelier.

Inspired by the values of the Reggio Emilia educational experience and the LEGO Idea, the DigiAtelier is a place where children and adults are invited to create with technology, from LEGO bricks to computers and new digital technologies. The research team is composed of two Atelieristas and one Maker Facilitator. The team will collaborate with the staff of the two Foundations.

Tasks and responsibilities:

The Atelieristas, with the support of the Maker Facilitator, will carry out the research and development of new playful and creative activities leading to the design of the atelier, taking also care of the educational and expressive contents. They will organise the atelier and the set-up of the space, and will draft the documentation. The Atelieristas will also be coordinating the welcome activities.

Requirements

- High School Diploma of Arts or Primary school teaching Diploma; Bachelor Degree of Arts, Bachelor Degree of Music or Bachelor Degree in Design is a plus.
- Proficient in MS Office Suite and InDesign
- Fluent in Italian and English
- Interested in digital technologies
- Willing to travel abroad
- Previous experience as an Atelierista in the school environment
- Strong respect for children and interest in learning more about the Reggio Emilia educational experience, values and philosophy are crucial.
